Following the publication of information in relation to me today, I would like to ask the PCC for assistance. My family and I have been contacted by the press on numerous occasions today following revelations involving Nathan Hageman.

Firstly, I wish to make clear that neither I nor my family wish to make any comment to the media on the situation. We would not like any further calls or visits from reporters or photographers. In addition to myself, my immediate family members, who have been contacted, are the following: Philip McLean; David Edwards; Susan Moores; Peter Moores; Catherine Moores; Michael Edwards; Doug McLean; Sylvia McLean; Helen Timmins; and Andrew Timmins.

Secondly, I am concerned about personal information which has already been published in regard to my private life, including the publication of my photograph. I am considering making a complaint to the PCC about the coverage under the terms of Clause 3 of the Code. I am also concerned about the potential publication of additional information which would intrude into my private life and which could compromise my safety and that of my family.
