**A CPS spokesperson said:**

The contract is in our possession and was used as evidence as part of the prosecution case against Clive Goodman and Glen Mulcaire. The email was not in the possession of the CPS and so did not form part of the examination that the DPP carried out earlier this week.

In light of your enquiry, we have today ascertained that the email, although not in the physical possession of the CPS, was within the unused material held by the Metropolitan Police (that is the material not used to prove the case against Goodman and Mulcaire). However, as in every case, all the unused material was seen by prosecution Counsel to determine whether or not it was capable of assisting the defence case or undermining the case for the prosecution in respect of Goodman and Mulcaire.

The DPP is now considering whether any further action is necessary.
