WITNESS STATEMENT OF GARY WESTON

I, Gary Weston of APCOA Parking UK Ltd, 2 Windmill Business Village, Brooklands Close, Sunbury-on-Thames TW16 7DY, WILL SAY as follows.

- 1. I have been employed by APCOA since 1999. I am a contract manager. In the past I have worked as a member of the civil staff of the Metropolitan Police. APCOA is a large parking management company and provides Parking Enforcement services to many local authorities. On 1 September 2002 the News of the World published an article entitled "Drug Traffic-kers" by Mazher Mahmood. The article alleged that APCOA Parking Attendant Staff in our Wandsworth contract were dealing in drugs in the course of their work. I was the contract manager at Wandsworth. An immediate Investigation was launched into the allegations, which was conducted by myself and APCOA's security manager Peter Griffiths.
- 2. It was apparent that the source of the story was Florim Gashi, who was working for APCOA. In the course of the investigation I interviewed Robin Hallsworth, who was Mr Gashi's supervisor. I was keen to ensure that I knew everything that might be relevant to this matter and I asked Mr Hallsworth to tell me anything that I ought to know. He volunteered the information that he had supplied Mr Gashi with a gun. He said that it was not a real gun and that he sold it to Gashi at his home outside working hours. At that time I had no cause to interview Mr Gashi regarding this matter.
- 3. Mr Hallsworth no longer works for APCOA. I am seeking to obtain information concerning his current whereabouts. I believe the facts stated in this witness statement are true.
